synopsis:

The story of Jesus Christ's crucifixion is one of betrayal, brutality, despair, and pain. Yet we know even before His death He promised redemption would be coming soon. We know that the story does not end at the cross. We know what many did not realize – that Sunday's comin'.

The life, death, and resurrection of Jesus all serve to teach us about the character of God. Specifically, the crucifixion and resurrection remind us that God has worked, is working, and will work through all things, even now as we find ourselves awaiting Christ's return.

discussion questions:

- Read Luke 22:42. What does Jesus' prayer say about His character in light of what was about to take place? What implications does this have for us as we strive to become Christ-like?
- In what ways does the concept "it's Friday, but Sunday's comin'" extend beyond the Easter story?
